UNIFORMS

Fitting

- **Band:** *The responsibilities include measuring and fitting band members for their uniforms and shoes, and compiling a list for new items to be ordered. It will also include taking the uniform jackets and vests to the designated dry cleaner once a year.*
- **Guard:** *The responsibilities include measuring and fitting guard members for their uniforms or costumes and shoes, and compiling a list for new items to be ordered.*

Sewing

This is a very general category that involves some minor alterations on uniforms and costumes. It could include major sewing of costumes for guard and/or band members or minor sewing tasks like adding buttons or snaps. (circle interests)

CHAPERONES

These are parents that are willing to ride the busses to and from the parades and competitions. They will take attendance on their designated bus and monitor the kids to and from the shows. Chaperones will need to assist kids in remembering the rules for travel as outlined. They will help direct the kids to the correct busses (boy and girl) for changing before and after the performances. This means staying with the kids prior to them taking the field at a competition and being at the busses (wherever they might be parked) directly after the show to maintain order and ensure timely changing etc... These are first come first served slots. To avoid confusion please do not show up to volunteer unless you have been contacted by the volunteer coordinator.

*Chaperones for Syracuse will be based on availability and the parents who volunteered the most throughout the season will be asked to chaperone first. Chaperoning in Syracuse includes checking bags, traveling with the kids on the busses for the weekend, staying with them in the hotel, checking rooms and making sure everyone is accounted for and behaving the entire time we are there. They will sit with the kids in the Carrier Dome in the designated area.
